

## Guideline for Quantitative Ingredient Declaration (QUID)

**QUID is included in the Regulation (EU) No 1169/2011 on the provision of food information to consumers. Article 22 describes the conditions under which quantitative declarations are required. Exemptions to the application of QUID are made where prior legislation defines quantities.**
