Peach RG: the following commentary note was added for sorbitol
“The sorbitol content of Turkish peaches may not reach the minimum value. Values between 1.0 and 1.5 g/kg have been observed.”

Apricot RG: the following commentary note was added for sorbitol
“The sorbitol content of Turkish apricot can exceed the maximum level. Values in excess of 20 g/kg can be observed.”

The following commentary note was added for citric acid:isocitric acid
“This ratio, in apricot from South Africa, can exceed the maximum. Values up to 200 have been observed.”

Aronia RG: regarding the parameter ‘sucrose’, ‘n.p.’ was replaced by ‘traces’ and the following commentary note was added
“Apart from freshly squeezed juice, there is no evidence of sucrose in aronia juice according to the chemical methods of analysis. Small amounts detected can be due to analytical methodology.”

Orange RG: regarding the parameter ‘sucrose’, the minimum value was modified from 10 to 25 g/l.

Kiwi RG: regarding the Brix level, it was modified as follows:

- From 11.5 to 10.9 (NFC)
- From 13.5 to 12.3 (FC)
