Document # 7 “Maximum levels of contaminants in fruit juice products” (under chapter #8): following the publication of [Regulation \(EU\) 2015/1005](#) amending Regulation (EC) 1881/2006, the maximum levels of **lead** in certain foodstuffs, including fruit juices, have been modified.

The document was also updated to include the modification agreed at the AIJN General Assembly of April 2015 with regard to **arsenic** in fruit juices (reduced from 0,1 to 0,05 mg/kg).

Finally, the [reference level](#) of **perchlorate** for intra-Union trade was also included.
