Document # 7 "Maximum levels of contaminants in fruit juice products" (under chapter #8): following the publication of Regulation (EU) 2015/1005 amending Regulation (EC) 1881/2006, the maximum levels of lead in certain foodstuffs, including fruit juices, have been modified.

The document was also updated to include the modification agreed at the AIJN General Assembly of April 2015 with regard to **arsenic** in fruit juices (reduced from 0,1 to 0,05 mg/kg).

Finally, the <u>reference level</u> of **perchlorate** for intra-Union trade was also included.
